The methodology included: cost analysis comparing TU data with other USA systems' data through regression, maintenance report sampling and analysis including hypothesis test for proportion level of confidence interval, Chi Square test comparing contractor's employees' salaries with PRHTA employees' salaries, risk analysis adapting both National Institute for Standards and Technology Special Publication 800-30 and MIL-STD-882B procedures, interview to professor in labor rights, among other procedures.
